NOTE: Admission to the Teacher Education Program requires the following: Submitting a Teacher Education program application to the UHV SoEHD, completing all lower level transfer courses, GPA of 2.50 or higher on lower level English courses, overall GPA of 2.50 or higher on lower division courses, completion of Nelson-Denny Exam, interview with faculty members.
