Notes/Comments:

- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for all First Time in College (FTIC) students at Lone Star College. If not FTIC, take COSC 1301 (less than 5 years old) to satisfy institutional requirement at UHV. Students who are FTIC are still required to complete COSC 1301.
- (2) BUSI 2301 and ACNT 1303 are only required for completion of the AAS degree. UHV does not required these courses for completion of the BAAS.
- (3) Students may be awarded credit at UHV for 24 to 44 vocational or technical credits earned within an Associate of Applied Arts and Sciences program at LSC.
- (4) Select from LGLA 1317, 1323, 1341, 1343, 1349, 1351, 1353, 1355, 1359, 2309, 2311, 2313, 2315, 2323.
- (5) Student may complete an additional 12 hrs. at LSC. The maximum credit hours permitted for transfer to UHV is 66. Students are strongly encouraged to consult with an advisor.
- (6) Students must complete 15 hours of UD business courses from at least two of the following areas: International Business, Management, or Marketing. No more than 9 hours may be taken in any one area.
- (7) Upper Division Free Electives may be selected from any UHV courses offered. The total of LD and UD coursework in any business discipline may not exceed 24 semester hours.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Application fees will be waived for LSC students and employees
- LSC students and employees can apply for all applicable scholarship programs
- LSC students and employees admitted to UHV will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHV
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHV will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHV Honors College with a minimum GPA of 3.5 and satisfaction of other Honors College admission criteria such as letter of application to the Honors Program
 - UHV will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credits
 - Honors transfer students will be eligible for merit and needbased aid commensurate with qualifications.

- Joint Admission provides students the opportunity to maximize utilization of facilities and programs offered jointly by LSC and UHV:
 - Student ID at LSC and UHV

 - o Free electronic transfer transcript transmission/evaluation

• Student must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA;

Program Admission

Requirements

- UHV will accept a "D" in courses taken at LSC, but student must ensure cumulate GPA is a 2.0 .
- If a student retakes a course, UHV will use the most recent grade attempted toward cumulative GPA calculation.
- Student with more than 9 hours of lower division business or business technology courses may not choose the General Business or Marketing concentrations.
- Student is encouraged to complete an Associate of Applied Science degree at Lone Star College.
- The BAAS at UHV is a 120 credit hour degree program. UHV will accept 24-44 hours (varies by concentration) of the occupational/technical courses, regardless of the required number of credit hours of occupational/technical courses for completion of the AAS degree.
